may be used to maintain traceability in materials for use in pressure equipment in all categories in which FORCE Certification A/S [FC] in its capacity of notified body number 0200 performs conformity assessment of pressure equipment; cf. PED.

Further the authorisation may be used for maintaining traceability in materials for use in pressure equipment in all inspection categories in which FC in its capacity of test body performs verification of pressure equipment, cf. the Danish Working Environment Authority's Executive Order on design, modification and repair No. 99 of 31 January 2007.

This authorisation may also be relevant for other notified bodies and test bodies.

The authorisation is subject to the condition that the manufacturer's work is performed according to the stated procedures, and that any proposed change of these influencing the quality of the finished products must be accepted by FC before it can be implemented.

The manufacturer makes all the necessary arrangements to ensure that re-marking and traceability take place in conformity with the essential safety requirements stated in PED, annex I.

FC performs inspection of re-marking and traceability of materials. This inspection is usually performed in connection with manufacture of pressure equipment and assemblies. Alternatively, inspections will take place unannounced.

The authorisation is valid for three years from date of issue. The manufacturer must give notice no later than three months before expiry if the agreement is to be renewed.
